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Alternative Learning

- Panther Academy has a total of 24 students in grades 7-12.
 - Middle School 6 students
 - High School 16 students
 - Out of District- 2 students
- Panther Academy has participated in several community service initiatives over the past few months.
 - Reading to Head Start students
 - Visiting and providing care packages to the LC Senior Citizen Center
 - Students are successfully transitioning back to their home school with intentional support.
 - Character Speakers visit the program monthly







Staff Support

- Weekly Surveys are sent to all school and departments to assess their needs and suppor

 - Dr. Hickson, myself and principals have access to the results
 - Areas of support can include: instruction, classroom management, personal challer or the need to purchase classroom or office supplies
 - We assess the needs and support results and find resources to support staff

NEw Teacher Induction and Mentoring

- Florence School District 3 currently have 28 Induction Teachers
 - Elem 19 Teachers
 - Secondary 9 Teachers
 - Each teacher has a school-level teacher mentor and is provided ongoing support
 - Topics covered so far include: Building Positive Relationships, Community Involvement, Empathy, Classroom Management, Instructional Practices, Social and Emotional Learning etc...
 - Induction teachers meet the 1st Monday of each month
 - Francis Marion University has partnered with FSD3 and are providing support to elementary Induction teachers through mentoring. Additionally, FMU attends monthly Induction meetings and presents on various topics in education as well.
- 13 teachers recently became certified mentors after completing the 12 hour CERRA Teacher Mentoring Certification Series
 - The feedback was very positive and the participants were very engaged in the work.
