Induction Contracts

Who Gets One?

- First-year teachers
- In-state teachers who have transferred from another district who have not completed all Induction levels.
- Out-of-state and non-public school teachers who have less than one year of teaching experience
- Out-of-state and non-public school teachers who have one or two years of teaching experience (*at the discretion of the district*)

Information

- A Person May Be Employed as an Induction Teacher for up to 3 years prior to advancing to an Annual contract.
- A District Can Non-Renew an Induction Teacher even if the Teacher is Successful or Unsuccessful
- No due process rights – the Teacher Employment and Dismissal Act does not apply

Annual Contracts

Who Gets One?

- Teachers who have successfully completed Induction
- In-state teachers who have transferred from another district who have not completed all Annual levels.
- Teachers who have more than two years of out-of-state or non-public school teaching experience
- Out-of-state and non-public school teachers who have one or two years of teaching experience (at the discretion of the district)

Information

- Must successfully complete an ADEPT summative (formal) evaluation in order to be eligible to advance to a professional teaching certificate and a continuing contract.
- Minimal due process rights – the Teacher Employment and Dismissal Act
- Teachers on an international visa are not eligible for a continuing contract and remain at the Annual contract level.

Continuing Contracts

Who Gets One?

- Teachers who have successfully completed the annual contract period and are certified by the state
- Teachers with out-of-state or nonpublic teaching experience who hold National Board Certification
- Must hold a Professional Teaching Certificate.

Information

- Full procedural due process rights relating to employment and dismissal.
- All teachers employed under continuing contracts must be evaluated on a continuous basis.
