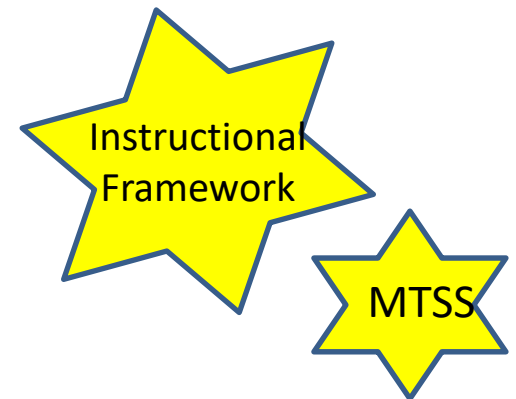
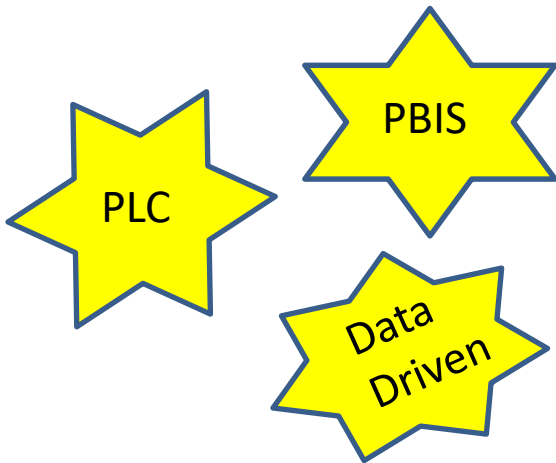
Board Goals
