

Ignite leverages research-based best practices for high-impact tutoring.

This includes:

- 1:3 ratio of tutor to student,
- 3-5 hours of instruction for 10-12 weeks,
- use of the school curriculum,
- consistent groupings, and
- tutor support and professional development from Teach for America and veteran educators.








