Early College/Dual Enrollment

School year 2022-2023

- Over 30 students participated.
- Average grade was 85
- 7 students earn a certificate in either Welding, IMT, HVAC, and Criminal Justice Technology from Florence Darlington Technical College.
- Over 80% of participating graduating students continued with their post secondary education.
- Of those 80% students reported that participating in FSD3's Early College and Dual Enrollment Program better prepared them for the *REALITIES* of college.

School year 2023-2024

- Currently 65 students participating.
- Average grade is a 92.
- 8 students will earn a certificate in either Welding, IMT, or HVAC.
- 2 students will earn their Associate of Arts Degree.
- 1 student will earn an their Associate of Science Degree.
- 1 student will earn both a Associate of Arts and Science Degree.
- Currently 45 graduating seniors have earn as many as 27 college credits.
- 100% of graduating seniors plan to continue their post secondary education either with a 2 year or 4 year college/university or military.

Community Support

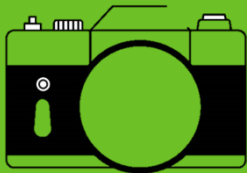

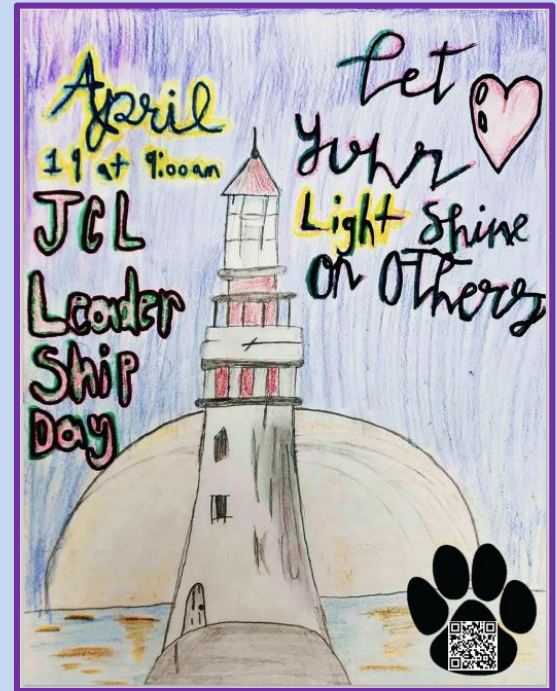
