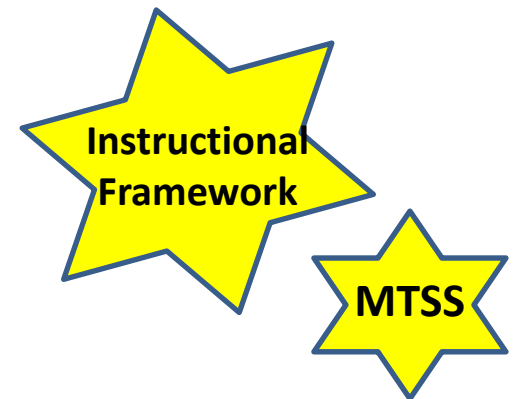
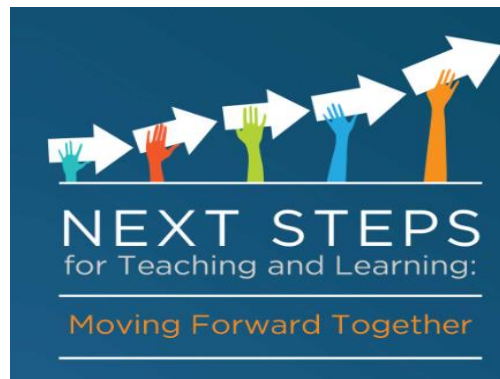
Board Goals
