 - Dec. 8, 2022- Principal PLO- analyze data, reviewed updates for Action Plans, interventions and small group instruction





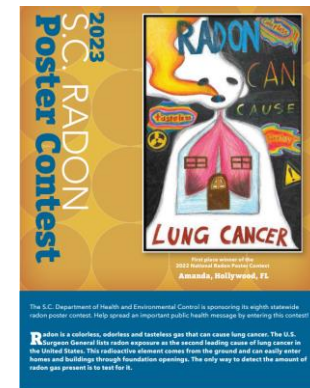

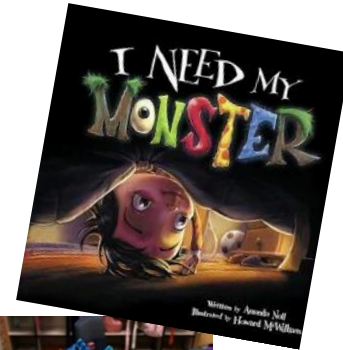
Quilt Making as an Art Form
