We are so excited about the focus we have in place to give our students the confidence they need to be successful on the End Of Year Assessments.













## Virtual Academy 21-22

Due to the nature of the Early Childhood curriculum and the age of the students, the virtual program will not be offered to 3K through 1<sup>st</sup> grade students. Additionally, grades 2-6 virtual options provided will depend on the number of requests per grade level. For example, if there are only three students registered and approved for 2<sup>nd</sup> grade, we may not be able to accommodate that request.

Students must apply and meet specific requirements to be accepted into the program. Those requirements include good standing in:

- Previous Virtual Attendance
- Previous Virtual Academic Progress
- Previous Virtual Conduct



## Virtual Academy 21-22 Commitments and Expectations

- 1- Year long commitment
- 2- Must use school issued device so that activity can be monitored
- 3- Must be visible on camera during instruction
- 4- Must attend all live sessions and complete work to be counted present
- 5- Must abide by same attendance and grading policies as F2F students
- 6- Must have reliable internet
- 7- Must complete required on-line trainings (parents and students)
- 8- Must be willing to test on site
- 9- Must adhere to virtual code of conduct
- 10- Must maintain a C or higher in academic coursework

Failure to meet requirements and commitments of the virtual program

1<sup>st</sup> offense- warning/ parent conference

2<sup>nd</sup> offense- written warning – improvement plan

3<sup>rd</sup> offense- Removal from virtual academy (student must attend face to face)

If a student is removed from the virtual academy, the student may not be eligible to reapply for virtual learning in the future.
