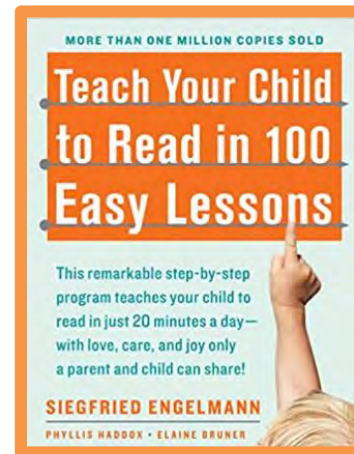

## The Wynns' College Boot Camp

- July 12-15 for high school students
  - July 19-22 for middle school students and high school students who were not able to participate during the previous week.
  - The four-day intensive boot camp challenges students to learn who they really are and to create realistic roadmaps for achieving their college dreams.
- Day 1--Gifts, Talents, Interests, Careers—Students work on activities to help them discover their own talents and personal intelligences.
  - Day 2--Researching Colleges and Programs—Students learn the differences between the types of colleges: Liberal Arts vs. Research Universities; Honors Colleges; Cooperative Education Programs; Dual Degree; Test Optional; HBCUs
  - Day 3--Paying for College—Students are introduced to methods of paying for college and learn how to expand their research to include colleges that may better fit their gifts and talents. Students also learn about FAFSA; Institutional Scholarship Research; and Specific Scholarships
  - Day 4--College Application and Scholarship Plan—Students put their research into action and narrow down those colleges that best suit them, keeping costs of each institution in mind. Discussions include topics such as Net Price for College; Common Applications; Coalition Application; Letters of Recommendations; and Senior Checklists.
