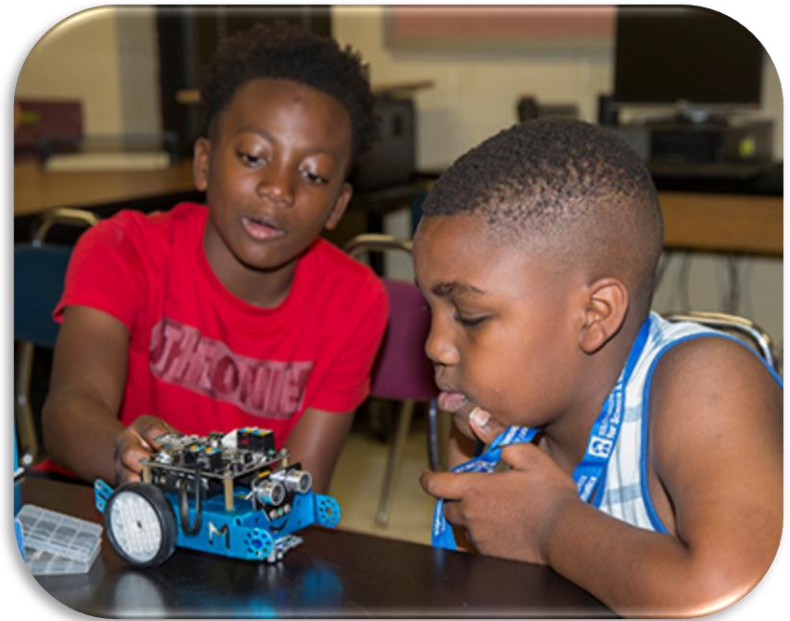

# Policy Revisions – E

- EA – Business Management Goals and Objectives
  - With the assistance of the superintendent and personnel designated by **him/her**, the school board shall establish efficient and businesslike procedures for fiscal accounting, purchasing and management of equipment and supplies.
- EB – Buildings and Ground Management
  - The care and custody of all school property shall be the general responsibility of the director of facilities. ~~/operations~~
- EBCA – Vandalism Protection

## Legal References

SC Code of Laws, 1976, as amended:

Section 16-7-170 - Entering public building for purpose of destroying records or other property.

Section 16-11-520 – Malicious injury to tree, house, outside fence or fixture; trespass upon real property.

Section 16-11-530 – Malicious injury to real property; school trustees deemed owner of school property.

Section 16-17-420 – Authority to take appropriate action.

Section 20-7-510, et. seq – Regarding duty of school authorities to report suspected cases of abuse and neglect.

Section 22-3-710 – Proceedings commenced on information.

Section 59-19-90(5) – General authority to manage and control property regarding district property.

Section 59-24-60 – Requires administration to contact law enforcement.



# Policy Revisions – E

- EDG - STUDENT TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT /ALCOHOL AND CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES TESTING
  - District administration shall be responsible for ensuring that all such employees receive appropriate education related to the requirements of this policy ~~and it's accompanying administrative rule~~, and that all recordkeeping and other requirements of the Act are met.
- EGAA – Worker's Compensation
  - The South Carolina Workers' Compensation law is designed to ~~provide~~ **permit** medical and monetary benefits for an employee who is injured while at work and as the result of an injury arising out of and in the course of his employment.
  - Under the Workers' Compensation law, it is the responsibility of the school district to ~~provide~~ offer medical treatment for employees injured on the job.
