- Testing Windows
  - SC Alt March 11 April 26
  - WIN Career Readiness Assessment March 27 April 19
  - SC Ready last 20 full school days
  - EOC last 15 full school days



- Goal 1
  - By 2025-2026
    - disabled students in grades 3-8
      - Met or higher ELA increase from 20% to 40%
      - met or higher for the math assessment will increase from 25% to 46%
    - ML population in grades 3-8 who score
      - Met or higher on the state ELA assessment will increase from 45% to 65%
      - Met or higher for math will increase from 30% to 50%.



- Goal 2–By 2025-2026,
  - Graduation Rate will increase from 72% to 80%
  - College and/or Career Readiness Rate will increase from 78% to 83%.
- Goal 3 By 2025-2026, FSD3's chronic absenteeism rate will decrease from 11.32% to 6%.



- Goal 4
  - By 2025-2026, the percentage of 3-8 GT students scoring met or above on the state assessment in ELA, math and science will be at or above 82%.
- Goal 5
  - By 2025-2026, the percentage of GT parents satisfied with the support services provided to gifted and talented students as measured by a district created survey will increase from 80% to 98%.



- Goal 6
  - By 2025-2026, a minimum of 85% of all stakeholders will be satisfied with the learning environment, the social and physical environment and the school-home relationships as measured by the state survey.
- Goal 7
  - By 2025-2026
    - Grades 3-8 met or above on the ELA will increase from 29% to 55%
    - English EOC passage rate will increase from 57% to 70%
    - ACT Reading and English proficiency rates
      - increase from an average composite score of 16 in Reading to an average composite score 26
      - increase in English from an average composite score 11 to an average composite score 21.



- Goal 8
  - By 2025-2026,
    - Grades 3-8 who score met or above on the math will increase from 23% to 48%
    - Math EOC passage rate will increase from 33% to 58%
    - ACT math proficiency rates will increase from an average composite score 11 to an average composite score of 25.
- Goal 9
  - By 2025-2026,
    - Grades 4 and 6 scoring meet or higher on the science will increase from 26% to 52%
    - ACT science portion will increase from an average composite score 15 to an average composite score 22 and the passage rate for science EOC will increase from 46% to 66 percent.



- Goal 10
  - By 2025-2026, the passage rate for students on the US History EOC test will increase from 37% to 57 percent.
- Goal 11
  - By 2025-2026, FSD3 will increase our teacher retention rate from 83% to a minimum of 93%.
