State Assessments

- WorkKeys Grades 11 & 12
 - March 21-April 29, 2022
- SC Ready & SC Pass- Grades 3-8
 - Last 20 days of school
- EOC Algebra I, Biology, English 2 & US History
 - Last 15 days of school





- Goal 1 By 2024-2025, 40% our disabled population in grades 3-8 will meet or exceed the state scores based on the state ELA assessment and 46% will meet or exceed the state scores on the math assessment and 65% of the ELL population in grades 3-8 will meet or exceed the state scores on the ELA assessment and 50% will meet or exceed the expected state scores on math.
- Goal 2 By 2024-2025, a minimum of 55% of all students in grades 3-8 will meet or exceed the expected state scores based on the SC Ready ELA assessments administered and English EOC passage rate will increase to 70% and ACT Reading and English proficiency rates will increase to at least 21%.
- Goal 3 By 2024-2025, FSD3's chronic absenteeism will decrease from 11.32% to 6%.



- Goal 4 By 2024-2025, a minimum of 48% of all students in grades 3-8 will meet or exceed the expected state scores based on the math assessments administered and math EOC passage rate will increase to 25% and ACT math proficiency rates will increase to at least 25%.
- Goal 5 By 2024-2025, a minimum of 52% of all students taking the science state assessment in grades 3-8, will meet or exceed state scores based on the state science assessment and at least 30% of the science portion of the ACT and 66% for the science EOC.
- Goal 6 -By 2024-2025, 57% of the students will pass the US History EOC test.



- Goal 7 By 2024-2025, the percentage of 3-8 GT students scoring met or above on the state assessment in ELA, math and science will be at or above 82%.
- Goal 8 By 2024-2025, a minimum of 85% of all stakeholders will be satisfied with learning environment, the social and physical environment and the school-home relationships as measured by the state survey.
- Goal 9 By 2024-2025, FSD3 will increase our teacher retention rate from 83% to a minimum of 93%.



- Goal 10 By 2024-2025, the percentage of GT parents satisfied with the support services provided to gifted and talented students as measured by a district created survey will increase from 80% to 90%.
- Goal 11 By 2024-2025, our Graduation Rate will increase from 72% to 80% and our College and/or Career Readiness Rate will increase from 78% to 85%.
