Proviso 1.108

- 1.108. (SDE: Mask Mandate Prohibition): No school district, or any of its schools, may use any funds appropriated or authorized pursuant to this act to require that its students and/or employees wear a facemask at any of its education facilities. This prohibition extends to the announcement or enforcement of any such policy.
- The South Carolina Department of Education (SCDE) interprets the above language to mean that school districts are prohibited from requiring students and employees to wear a facemask while in any of its educational facilities for the 2021-22 school year. Educational facilities include all property owned and operated by the individual district.



Proviso 1.108

- In a memo to all district school districts earlier this month, State Superintendent of Education, Molly Spearman said her agency also has decided it will no longer enforce masks on buses either. In fact, any district that tries to put in a mandatory mask mandate, could face a penalty. "Should a district decide to act contrary to this law, state funding may be withheld," Spearman wrote.

- ✓ Ms. Bowens-Seabrook recommended the following revisions
 - 1. Page 1; Under subtitle 'Competitive foods and beverages', 3rd sentence remove administrative rule EFE-R and enter "Policy EEA".
 - 2. Also, remove the last sentence of this paragraph.
 - 3. In the last paragraph on page 1, last sentence remove "administrative rule EFE-R" and add "Exempt Fundraisers Memorandum 2015"
 - 4. Under subtitle 'Nutrition promotion', 2nd paragraph, 2nd sentence remove "the use of" and add "using"; remove"... adherent to a policy of 100% of foods and beverages promoted to students" and add "strategies and best practices..."
 - 5. Still page 2; under subtitle 'District Wellness Committee/Coordinated District Health Advisory Council', 1st paragraph add "(Refer to LWP contacts)"
 - 6. Page 3; Add the "Local Wellness Contact Listing" with contact names and information.
