### Can students begin earlier?

Currently, State law requires that students begin no earlier than the 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of August. Should this change, we will be able to consider a new calendar.

### **Step One:**

Members of the <u>Calendar Committee</u> (representatives from each location) created/reviewed Calendar Drafts.

### **Step Two:**

Proposed Calendar Drafts presented to <u>all staff members</u> for selection (vote). Originally sent in January, with only 300 votes, we elected to host Calendar presentation meetings <u>to all staff</u> to ensure <u>everyone had the opportunity</u> to review the calendar and vote.

### Step Three:

The Calendar with the <u>majority votes</u> presented to the School Board for approval.

## FSD3 Vaccine Plan

- I have communicated already with MUSC and McLeod and FSD3 is on the list. We have a prioritized list ready for action:
- Priority Group 1: Nurses, Speech, Special Ed self contained, and staff with identified heath issues, and staff over 55

There are 68 staff in this category and 29 have agreed or may take the vaccine.

 Priority Group 2: F2F Teachers, support staff, bus drivers, cafeteria workers, custodians, and administrators

There are 432 staff in this category and 249 have agreed or may take the vaccine.

Priority Group 3 - Teachers who are 100% Virtual

There are 37 staff in this category and 28 have agreed or may take the vaccine.



## **COVID Leave**

- The Family First Corona Virus Response Act that gave employees 80 hours of sick leave and child care time expired December 31, 2020.
- FSD3 extended the COVID leave until March 31 in order to remove a burden for employees who truly need these hours.
- Some districts are extending the time further using additional ESSER funds allocated by the SDE.
- I would like to recommend extending the sick leave portion to the Family First Corona Virus Response Act until the end of the 2020-2021 SY.



## Legislative Updates

•The House will consider a bill giving voters another opportunity to vote if they think the State Superintendent should be appointed by the Governor. If voters approve the amendment, the governor would begin picking, with the advice and consent of the Senate, the state superintendent in 2024.
