LEGISLATIVE UPDATES


- Bill [H. 3247](#) requires that schools provide up to 10 excused absences for students to participate in a career and technical student organization experience. Participation may include, but is not limited to, scheduled events of state-level Future Farmers of America (FFA) and 4-H programs. Students are responsible for completing any missed assignments. The bill has been enrolled for ratification and once ratified will proceed to the governor's desk for his signature.



LEGISLATIVE UPDATES

The Senate Committee amended several items under Bill [H. 3196](#) - The Educator Assistance Act.

- One amendment states that the local board, through the superintendent, must notify teachers in writing by May 1 of their employment status. \$100,000 penalty if not done.
- Require a district to provide a teacher, upon request, with the factors used to determine their pay category on the salary schedule.
- Specify that a teacher must be notified in writing five days in advance of a reassignment to work at another location unless the “superintendent demonstrates an advance notice cannot be accomplished because of a critical student need or the teacher requested the reassignment.”
