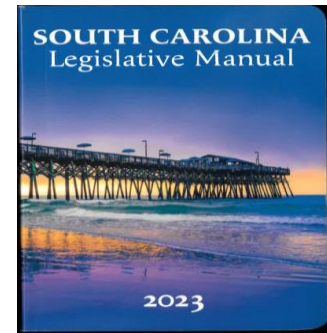

LEGISLATIVE UPDATES

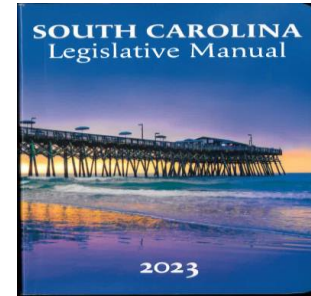


New or Amended Provisos:

Note that provisos with only updated date references are not included below:

- **1.3 - State Aid to Classrooms:** Increases teacher salary schedule and requires monthly reporting of fund balance.
- **1.47 - Full-Day 4K:** Requires the EOC to collect daily attendance data for CERDEP students.
- **1.70 - Teacher Salaries/SE Average:** Updates the proviso to reflect the current Southeastern average salary.

LEGISLATIVE UPDATES



- **1.78 - Funding for Schools Safety:** Directs the SDE to make funds available to schools for facilities upgrades aligned with school safety priorities:
 - (a) classroom/internal door locks;
 - (b) secure school entry points and access control;
 - (c) window covers;
 - (d) bulletproof glass or bulletproof film for windows; and
 - (e) electronic or other technology.
- **1.103 - Anti-Bullying/School Safety:** Requires school districts to implement a policy adopted by the State Board of Education that prohibits cell phone access during the school day.
- **1.104 - District Accounting Systems and Best Practices:** Establishes a study committee to examine and propose necessary revisions for improving district accounting systems and best practices.
